ITINERARY

Monday October 25, 2010

Transatlantic

Leave New York. We must be at airport at least 3 hours before flight time.

ENROUTE TRANSATLANTIC

Tuesday October 26, 2010

Tel Aviv

Today, we arrive in Tel Aviv at approximately 5pm. Upon arrival, we are met and assisted by our guide and transferred to our hotel in Tel Aviv.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT TEL AVIV

Wednesday October 27, 2010

Caesarea / Haifa / Mt. Carmel / Megiddo / Nazareth / Tiberias

On the way to the Galilee, we drive along the Mediterranean coast to the ruins of the ancient Roman capital, Caesarea, built by Herod the Great in 22 BC. Visit the Roman Theatre, the Aqueduct and Herodian Port. Continue to Haifa, to see the magnificent panoramic view from Mount Carmel and to the Mukraka, the location of Elijah's altar. We visit the Valley of Armageddon and the excavation of Tel Megiddo, going all the way back to the Canaanite period. Then we travel to Jesus' boyhood home of Nazareth where we visit Nazareth Village, the Church of the Annunciation and Mary's Well on our way to Tiberias

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT TIBERIAS

Thursday October 28, 2010

**Boat Ride / Mount of Beatitudes / Tabgha / Capernaum /
Caesarea Phillipi / Golan Heights / Yardenit / Tiberias**

Take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Afterwards we visit the Mount of Beatitudes, site of the Sermon on the Mount and Tabgha, site of the Miracle of the Fishes and the Loaves. Then we journey

to Capernaum, the city of Jesus and then cross the Jordan River to the land of Gaderenes. Visit Caesarea Phillipi and the Golan Heights. Return to Tiberias by the way of Yadenit on the Jordan River where you can be baptized.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT TIBERIAS

Friday October 29, 2010

Tiberias / Beth Shean / Gideon Springs / Jordan Valley / Bethlehem

Depart Tiberias to the newly excavated ruins of Beth Shean where the bodies of Saul and his sons were displayed on the walls after their defeat at Mount Gilboa. Drive to Gideon Springs where 300 men, those who did not bend down and lapped the water from the spring were selected for the victorious battle. Continue via the Jordan Valley to Jerusalem. After checking into our hotel we drive to nearby Bethlehem for a visit to the Church of the Nativity, viewing the Shepherd's Fields and the Fields of Boaz and Ruth.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

Saturday October 30, 2010

**Jerusalem / Old City / Mt. of Olives /
Gethsemane / City of David / Siloam Pool / Hezekiah's Tunnel**

Drive to the Mount of Olives for an outstanding view of the city and surrounding area. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension, Garden of Gethsemane, and Church of All Nations. See the Kidron Valley, Tomb of Absalom, Zachariah and James. We then visit the City of David that includes excavated fortresses and passageways from David's conquest of the Jebusite city as described in the 2nd book of Samuel. City of David is where Jerusalem started. Visit the Siloam Pool on the southern slope of City of David. Here Jesus cured the blind man with a mud. Continue to visit Hezekiah's Tunnel that runs from the Gihon Spring to the Pool of Siloam. This tunnel acted as an aqueduct to provide Jerusalem with water during a siege.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

Sunday October 31, 2010

**Jerusalem / Old City / Davidson Center / Kotel Tunnel / Via Dolorosa /
Church of the Holy Sepulchre / Room of the Last Supper / David Tomb**

On our morning walking tour of the Old City we visit the Davidson Center, a recently excavated archeological site near the southern wall of Temple Mount in the Old City. We proceed to the Temple area on Mt. Moriah, see the Dome of the Rock, see Mosque El Aqsa. Visit the Western Wall, the Kotel Tunnel, Golden Gate and the Pinnacle. St. Stephen's Gate, the Pool of Bethesda, the Chapel of the Flagellation, and the Ecce Homo Arch. We view the Gabbadia pavement and continue through the Bazaar to the last stations of the Via Dolorosa – Church of Sepulchre. We also visit the Cardo, followed by Mt. Zion, the Room of the Last Supper and King David's Tomb.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

Monday November 1, 2010

Jerusalem / New City / Garden Tomb / Bridges for Peace Center

Drive via the Hebrew University and the Knesset, to the Israel Museum. Visit Yad Vashem, the Holocaust memorial. Visit the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scroll collection is exhibited. Climaxing the day, we visit the Garden Tomb of Jesus, followed by an orientation beside Calvary and communion.

Afternoon: Visit the Bridges for Peace Center in Jerusalem.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

Tuesday November 2, 2010

Jerusalem / Dead Sea / Qumran / Ein Gedi / Masada / Arava / Eilat

Leave Jerusalem on our way to the Shore of the Dead Sea -the deepest point on earth (1200 feet below sea level). Visit Qumran where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. Drive to the Nature Reserve at Ein Gedi, where King David found shelter from the rage of King Saul. Continue to Masada. Ascend to Masada by cable car to visit these magnificent ruins. Masada is the fortress where from 70-73 AD

Jewish Zealots made the last stand against the Roman Empire. Then enjoy a short swim in the Dead Sea and continue via the Arava Wilderness to Eilat.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT EILAT

Wednesday November 3, 2010

Petra /Aqaba - Jordan

Early morning after breakfast we cross the border to Jordan and drive north to Petra.

This entire city, with its rose colored temples and amphitheatre is carved out of multiple rocks which surround the hidden valley. The city was lost to the rest of the world until approximately a hundred years ago. St. Paul studied here for three years and Herod the Great came from Petra. After our visit to Petra, we travel south to the port city of Aqaba for a short city tour and cross the border back to Israel where you will be transferred back to your hotel.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT EILAT

Thursday November 4, 2010

**Timna / Solomon Pillars / Beer Sheva /
Ashkelon / Valley of Ella / Jaffa / Airport**

We depart Eilat and head north to visit Solomon Pillars and his copper mines in Timna.

We continue via the Ramon Crater to Beer Sheva (seven wells in Hebrew), mentioned in Genesis as the location where the servants of Isaac dug the seven wells. Drive to Ashkelon – a Philistine city and via the Valley of Ella, where David fought Goliath to Jaffa, the home of Simon the Tanner and the place where Jonah set sail. We have a dinner in a local restaurant and after dinner we transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our flight back home.

We've seen spectacular sights, enjoyed unforgettable experiences together and alone. We've sung frequently, laughed a lot, cried a little, built lifelong relationships and, best of all, gained a unique appreciation and familiarity with God's Word that only comes with "being there."

DINNER JAFFA

Friday November 5, 2010

Israel / USA

Transatlantic flight home. Arrival in New York early morning on Friday.
