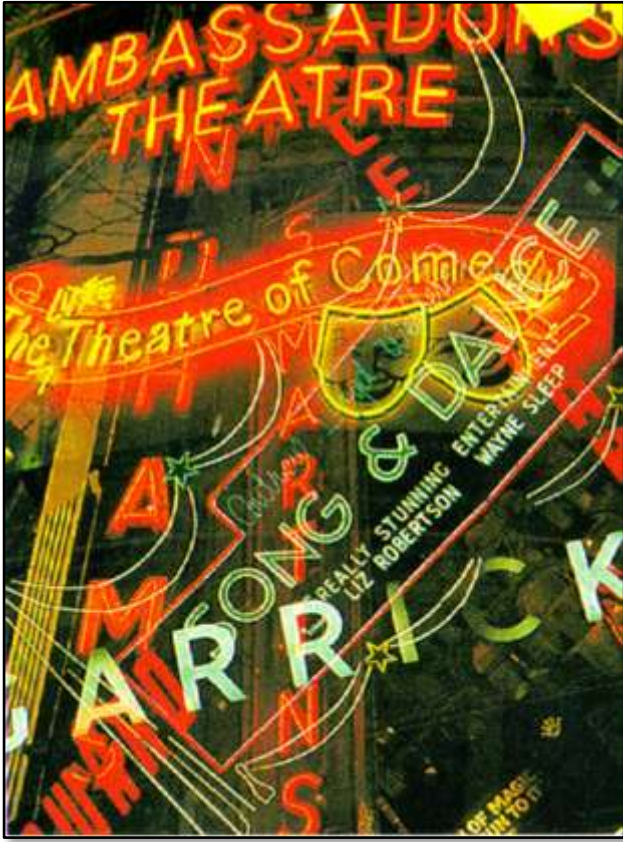

Dec 29-Wednesday
