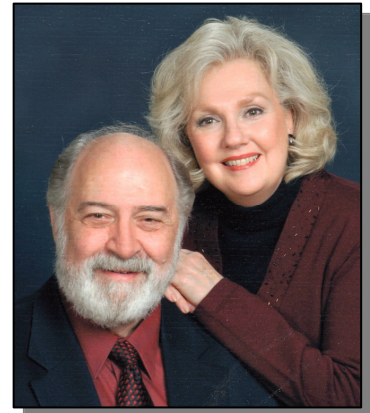

Dec. 27

USA-En Route

Relax in comfort during your overnight Continental Airlines flight to England. Change planes in Newark.

Dec 28

London

Before you know it, your London host has your baggage aboard a waiting motor-coach and you're bound for your four star London Hotel, the Copethorne Tara. You'll be treated to impeccable service during your stay, while relishing the great location in Kensington. On the way to the hotel we drive around the West End, Piccadilly Circus, Trafalgar Square, and perhaps see the red-jacketed guards of Buckingham Palace. We proceed for a visit to 11th-century Westminster Abbey. After our guide tells tales of kings, queens and poets, the day is free to do as you please. One option: continue your sightseeing in the old City with stops at St. Paul's Cathedral and the Tower of London.

Dec. 29

London
