ITINERARY

Nov 8

Transatlantic

Depart San Francisco to Tel Aviv. We must be at the airport at least 2 hours before flight time. Enjoy our on-board transatlantic experience.

ENROUTE TRANSATLANTIC

Nov 9

Tel Aviv

Today, we arrive in Tel Aviv. Upon arrival, we are met and assisted by our guide. Our coach is waiting and we are transferred to our hotel in Tel Aviv for an Israeli dinner and a good night's rest.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT TEL AVIV

Nov 10

Caesarea / Mt. Carmel / Megiddo /

Nazareth / Tiberias

This morning after our full Israeli breakfast, we travel along the Mediterranean coast to the ruins of Caesarea, the ancient Roman capital, built by Herod the Great in 22 BC. The apostle Paul was imprisoned here before being sent to Rome. Pilate lived here during the time of Jesus' crucifixion. Cornelius and his household lived here too. Visit the Roman Theatre, the Aqueduct and Herodian Port. Continue toward Haifa, to see the magnificent panoramic view from Mount Carmel. Visit the Mukraka, the location of Elijah's altar where he slew the prophets of Baal. Afterwards, we drive to visit the Valley of Armageddon and the excavation of Tel Megiddo which is 30 civilizations deep going back to the Canaanites. Here too is Ahab's water tunnel and Solomon's stables. Then we travel to Jesus' boyhood home of Nazareth, and visit Nazareth Village before continuing to Tiberias.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT TIBERIAS

Nov 11

Boat Ride / Mount of Beatitudes / Tabgha / Capernaum / Caesarea Phillipi / Golan Heights / Yardenit

Take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, then visit the Mount of Beatitudes, site of the Sermon on the Mount. Visit Tabgha where Jesus fed 5000 with the loaves and the fishes of a small boy. Then continue to Capernaum, the city of Jesus and Simon Peter's house where the paralytic was healed. Cross the Jordan River to the land of Gaderenes. Visit Caesarea Phillipi, site of pagan altars, where Peter confessed Christ. Journey back toward Tiberias via the Golan Heights learning of Israel's great victory over Syria in recent history. Then to Yardenit on the Jordan River where you can be baptized before returning to your hotel.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT TIBERIAS

Nov 12

Beth Shean / Judean Hills / Bedouin Lunch / Bethlehem / Jerusalem

On our way to Jerusalem we start the day at the newly excavated ruins of Beth Shean where the bodies of Saul and his sons were displayed on the walls after their defeat at Mount Gilboa. Continuing, we stop in the Judean Hills for an authentic Bedouin lunch in "Abraham's tent." Arriving in Jerusalem we check into our hotel and afterwards travel to nearby Bethlehem for a visit to the Church of the Nativity site of the cave in which Jesus was born. We view the Shepherd's Fields and the Fields of Boaz and Ruth and have a short time to shop for olive wood and other souvenirs.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

Nov 13

Dead Sea / Masada / Ein Gedi

Leave Jerusalem for the Shore of the Dead Sea -the deepest point on earth (1200 feet below sea level). Drive along the Dead Sea via Ein Fescha to Massada. Ascend to Masada by cable car to visit these magnificent ruins. Masada is the fortress where from 70-73 AD the Jewish Zealots made the last stand against the Roman Empire. Then drive to the Nature Reserve Ein Gedi, where King David found shelter from the rage of King Saul. Enjoy a short swim in the Dead Sea and return to Jerusalem via the Judean Wilderness

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

Nov 14

Jerusalem / Old City

Drive to the Mount of Olives for an outstanding view of the city and surrounding area. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension, Garden of Gethsemane, and Church of All Nations. See the Kidron Valley, Tomb of Absalom, Zachariah and James. Our morning walking tour is of the Old City. We proceed to the temple area on Mt. Moriah, see the Dome of the Rock, see Mosque El Aqsa, visit the Western Wall, and walk through the Kotel Tunnel. We also visit the Golden Gate, the Pinnacle, St. Stephen's Gate, the Pool of Bethesda, the Chapel of the Flagellation and the Ecce Homo Arch. We view the Gabbadian pavement and continue through the Bazaar to the last stations of the Via Dolorosa. Visit the Cardo, Mt Zion, the Room of the Last Supper and King David's Tomb.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

Nov 15

Jerusalem / Old and New City

This morning, we will visit the Davidson Center, a recently excavated archeological site near the southern wall of Temple Mount in the Old City. We have a virtual walk through the temple as it was at the time of Jesus. Afterwards we proceed via the Hebrew University and the Knesset to the Israel Museum. Visit Yad Vashem, the holocaust memorial. Visit the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scroll collection is exhibited. Climaxing the day, we visit the Garden Tomb of Jesus, followed by an orientation beside Calvary and a communion.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

Nov 16

USA

We've seen spectacular sights, enjoyed unforgettable experiences together and alone. We've sung frequently, laughed a lot, cried a little, built lifelong relationships and, best of all, gained a unique appreciation and familiarity with God's Word that only comes with "being there." We transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for departure. Arrive in San Francisco the same day.

1. Coach class flight from San Francisco to Tel Aviv and back.
2. 7 nights lodging double occupancy in first class hotels.
3. Full Israeli breakfast and dinner daily.
4. Touring coach & English-speaking, government-licensed guide on the sightseeing days.

6. Entrances to sites listed in itinerary.
7. Portage of 1 piece of luggage per person on arrival and departure from each hotel.
8. Local government hotel taxes at the current prevailing rates.
9. Visit to Davidson Center
