#### **October 1**

**Vancouver / Kamloops**

Your motorcoach will transfer our group to the rail station. Travel onboard the Rocky Mountaineer from the coastal city of Vancouver to Kamloops, in the heart of British Columbia's interior. On today's journey you will see dramatic changes in scenery, from the lush green fields of the Fraser River valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade mountains, to the desert-like environment of the interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River. Your day concludes as the Rocky Mountaineer travels along the shores of Kamloops Lake and into Kamloops.

**OVERNIGHT KAMLOOPS, BRITISH COLUMBIA**

#### **October 2**

**Kamloops / Jasper**

Our journey continues North and East to the mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of Alberta. Once again you will be surrounded by dramatic scenery as you follow the banks of the North Thompson River through the Monashee and Cariboo mountains, climbing ever nearer to the high peaks of the Continental Divide. Today's highlights include Mount Robson, at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet) the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. Pyramid Falls, and the climb over the Yellowhead Pass into Jasper National Park. Our rail journey ends on arrival in the resort town of Jasper this evening.

**OVERNIGHT JASPER, ALBERTA**

**October 3**

**Jasper Highlights**

Breakfast is included this morning before we venture on a half day tour. Jasper National Park is a World Heritage Site and Canada's largest National Park. Today, you will enjoy a scenic tour including the many natural attractions, rugged peaks, and perhaps even catch a glimpse of some of the many creatures that call this mountain park home. The remainder of the day is free for you to explore more of Jasper independently. We enjoy dinner together this evening.

**DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JASPER, ALBERTA**

**October 4**

**Jasper / Lake Louise**

After breakfast travel to Lake Louise via one of the most scenic highways in the world, the Icefields Parkway. A stop will be made at Athabasca Falls before arriving at the Columbia Icefield. Here you will ride on an Ice Explorer to the middle of the Athabasca Glacier to learn more about its geological features. Your driver/guide will explain how glaciers are formed and point out some interesting geological features. Time will be available for lunch. Afterwards, a brief stop will be made at Bow Lake before arriving in Lake Louise this afternoon.

**DINNER AND OVERNIGHT LAKE LOUISE, ALBERTA**

**October 5**

**Lake Louise / Banff**

Breakfast this morning is included before embarking on a tour that takes you into Yoho National Park to view some of its natural wonders. Among the attractions are the Spiral Tunnels, Emerald Lake and a natural rock bridge that spans the Kicking Horse River. Upon arrival into Banff you'll have some free time to relax or explore.

**OVERNIGHT BANFF, ALBERTA**

**October 6**

**Banff / Calgary**

We will have an early breakfast before enjoying a sightseeing tour of Banff. Among the points of interest are Bow Falls, Lake Minnewanka, Surprise Corner and the Hoodoos. Reach new heights today on the Banff Gondola that will whisk you away to an elevation of 2,281 m (7,486 ft.) above sea level to the top of Sulphur Mountain in Banff. Enjoy a 360° unobstructed view of the breathtaking Rocky Mountains. Lunch at this magnificent location will be provided. Upon arrival into Calgary you will enjoy a wonderful farewell dinner with your group at the local attraction restaurant in the Calgary Tower.

**DINNER AND OVERNIGHT CALGARY, ALBERTA**

**October 7**

**Calgary**
